

Richard Johnston wins Central Seniors Open by three shots at Glenbervie

Glenbervie scratch player Richard Johnston showed the opposition in a field of well over a 100 a clean pair of heels to win the Central Scotland Seniors Open over his home course by three strokes. Richard had rounds of 72 and 73 for a total of 145, which included a double bogey 6 at the ninth in his second-round halves of 37.

Second place on 148 was shared by four competitors - Laurie Chancellor (Inverness) 74-74, Gareth Bradley (Bramhall) 74-74, Kenneth Gallacher (East Kilbride) 73-75 and Jim Kinloch (Cardross) 71-77. Jim had shared the overnight lead but he had marked up seven bogeys in his second round before he gained his first and only birdie at the 17th.

Nevertheless, Jim came away from Glenbervie with a smile on his face as he had easily the best net score of 138, off a handicap of 5.
