Qualifying Event for SSGS/ SGL Seniors Order of Merit

Format

All Competitors play 36 holes qualifying Stroke play. Where necessary, a handicap ballot will reduce the field to 90 players.

The leading 32 qualifiers progress to the Matchplay stages. In the event of a tie for 32nd place there will be a countback based on the last 18, 9, 6 and 3 holes failing which a hole by hole countback.

Qualifiers will be seeded in an automatic draw, also separated by countback.

The Super Seniors Matchplay Championship will run in conjunction with the main SSGS matchplay event at Southernness. Members aged 65 or over at 00.01 hours on the 27th September may either restrict their involvement to trying to qualify for the Super Seniors Matchplay event only or they may enter for the main matchplay event. If a Super Senior qualifies for the main matchplay event he must play in that event. A Super Senior who does not qualify for the main event will be given the opportunity to play in the matchplay stages of the Super Seniors event if he has qualified on the basis of his net aggregate score.

QUALIFICATION To be eligible entrants must:

- be male at birth and be of Amateur Status as defined by R&A Rules Limited, a declaration to that effect being in the entry form;
- be over 50 years at 00.01hours on 27thSeptember 2021
- be in possession of a handicap under the current CONGU Unified Handicapping System or the handicapping scheme adopted in the country from which the entrant has entered;
- Be either born in Scotland, have a Scottish born parent, or have been permanently resident in Scotland for a period of not less than five years, and be a member of a recognised golf club.
- Not have played in a national closed competition nor have represented internationally a country other than Scotland.
