

# SCOTTISH SENIORS GOLFING SOCIETY PRESIDENTS CUP TERMS OF THE COMPETITION



20-21st May 2021

## Ladybank Golf Club

The following must be read in conjunction with the Scottish Seniors Golfing Society General Terms of the Competition.

Handicap Limit: 9.4 unless existing SSGS Member  
Entry Fee: £40  
Field Size: 129  
Closing Date: 20th April 2021 @ 12 Noon

### 1. Eligibility

To be eligible entrants must be:

- a) Male and of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited, and be members of SSGS.
- b) In possession of a handicap not exceeding 9 (exact 9.4), unless existing SSGS member when higher handicaps allowed
- c) Be aged 50 or over on 20th May 2021

### 2. Entries

The starting field will be made up as follows:

- a) Entries up to maximum 129 at closing date. In the event of being oversubscribed a ballot will be carried out with preference initially will be given to those players who scored points in the Main OOM, and the top 40 from the Super Seniors Gross OOM, in the preceding year. Thereafter normal ballot rules will apply.

- a) The championship shall consist of a scheduled 36 holes of stroke play contested over 2 days.
- b) The winner of the Scratch and Handicap event shall be the player returning the lowest gross or net 36 hole score.
- c) In the event of a tie for 1st place a card countback will be conducted over last 18, 9, 6, 3 then 1 hole. In the event that a tie remains, the winner will be decided by drawing of lots.
- d) Caddies are permitted.
- e) Play shall be from White Tees.
- f) Local Rules will be advised on the day

### 4. Winner and Prizes

There will be vouchers awarded for Scratch & Handicap results. The number and value of vouchers will be dependent on number of entries received.

The Presidents Cup will be awarded to the player with the lowest gross score over 2 rounds. In the event of a tie, countback rules, as above will apply.

The Vice-Presidents Cup will be awarded to player aged 65 or over with the lowest gross score over 2 rounds. In the event of a tie, countback rules, as above, will apply.

No player may win more than one prize.

Any trophies will be awarded at SSGS Annual Dinner, and shall be retained by Scottish Seniors Golfing Society.
