Conditions of Membership

1. Members agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of the Society.
2. Application for membership will be accepted from players with handicaps not exceeding the maximum at time of application- currently 9.4.
3. Annual Subscriptions are due annually by 31st January.
4. The Society's Regional and Match Play competitions are "Open" and, in the event of entries beyond the maximum, will be subject to ballot.
5. Entries for all events will be open to players age 50 and above as at the starting date for the competition, except for Super Senior Events where the age limit is 65 and above.
6. Where a ballot requires to be introduced for an event due to maximum number of entries being received by closing date, then a ballot will be conducted. Ballot rules can be viewed on our website.
7. The Committee will, at its discretion, adjust the maximum handicap permitted for new applicants.
8. Where an entrant is unable to take his place in an event, he must notify his withdrawal as soon as possible. Where an entrant fails to turn up without reasonable explanation, he may be subject to a period of suspension from future events at the discretion of the Committee.
9. Standard of behaviour when at our host clubs must always respect the traditions of those clubs and be in line with the high standards expected of reputable and experienced senior amateur golfers.
