## All SSGS Super Senior Strokeplay Competitions (Except 3-day International)

The following must be read in conjunction with the SSGS Golf General Terms of the Competition.

Handicap Limit:	15.4 for new members. Existing members with higher handicaps can enter
Entry Fee:	£40
Field Size:	60
Closing Date:	28 days prior to event at 12:00 noon

### 1. Eligibility

To be eligible entrants must be:

- Male and of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- Over the age of 65 years at 00:01 on the 1st day of the tournament.
- Be a member of SSGS, or as a guest provided you have not played in any SSGS events previously.

### 2. Conditions

- Each event shall comprise of a scheduled 36 holes of stroke play contested over 2 days with 18 holes played on each day.
- The Scratch and Handicap winners will be the competitor returning the lowest 2 round gross and Nett score.
- In the event of a tie for first place after 2 rounds, the event shall be decided by a card count back over the last 18 holes, then 9 holes, then last 6, 3 and 1.
- Prizes will be awarded across a single age category of 65+. The only exception to this will be for the Super Seniors Open where there will also be an additional age category of 70 and over
- Caddies are permitted. .

### 3. Winner and Prize

No trophies are presented for winners of Super Senior Events (Except Super Seniors Open). Only 1 voucher (of higher value) can be won per player.

All prize vouchers across all categories will be issued and distributed with 28 days from completion of event. Prize vouchers will be valid for 12 months only.
