- d. Scratch OOM. (only).

SSGS, Main Event

- a. Top 15, 65+ players receive points to 40th place
- b. 65+ player will receive additional Bonus Points from his position on the Main & SS Points Table
- c. Scratch & H/cap OOM.

SS 3 Days Event International Masters

- a. Points allocated to 20th place
- b. Scratch & H/cap OOM.

SS Event, 2 Day

- a. Points allocated to 15th place
- b. Scratch & H/cap OOM

Matchplay Championship

- a. Scratch OOM. (only).

SS Matchplay Handicap Championship

- a. H/cap OOM. (only)

Bonus Point (BP) Main Events

- a. The leading 65+ player playing a main event (East of Scotland etc) receives 200 points.
- b. 2nd 65+ player receives 180 points.
- c. 3rd 65+ player receives 160 points, down to 15th place as per points table.
- d. Any 65+ player finishing in the top 15 will receive additional BP's relative to his position on the leaderboard.

**Note: 65+ players must finish in the Top 40 Gross of a Main Event to receive any scratch points.
65+ players receive Scratch and Nett points from the same counting event.**

Examples ...(BP)... Main Events

The leading 65+ player finishing 3rd overall will receive additional BPs of.. 160 200 total = 360

The 2nd 65+ player finishing 14th overall will receive additional BPs of..... 50 180 total = 230

The 3rd 65+ player finishing 16th overall will receive 'NO' BPs 0 160 total = 160

Bonus Points (BP) British & Scottish Championship

Same rules apply. British & Scottish Points table.

Note: 65+ players must make cut to receive any points.

SSGS. S.Seniors OOM.

- a. The winners of the Scratch and Nett OOM must play a minimum of 6 events.
- b. Top 5 players from the Scratch OOM gain automatic selection to, SSGS v UKSGA.
- c. To gain automatic selection a player must play a minimum of 6 events.
- d. Team Selection, 10 man team
- e. Captain (John Fraser), + 4 captain picks, + 5 automatic places.
